Intent: Ashland Healthy Harvest, Inc. provides grants to support its mission of contributing to a vibrant town center; creating access to local food choices; improving public health through information and education about nutrition, diet, exercise, local and sustainable farming, and related topics; and contributing to community building.

Who Can Apply: Public entities, nonprofit corporations, and community groups.

Grant Amount: Up to \$1,000. Application Deadline: March 15, 2016

Guidelines:

The Ashland Healthy Harvest, Inc. Mini-Grant program provides funding for projects that support our mission as a 501C3 non-profit and must serve the greater Ashland community.

The 2016 Ashland Farmers Market is committed to improving and expanding on-site recycling to include stations for the proper disposal of compost (including biodegradable plastics), recycling of non-compostable materials and trash.

Although grants can be used for a variety of projects, award preference will be given to applications that complement or enhance the Ashland Farmers Market 2016 recycling and composting initiative. Applications that address education about the use of compostable materials or applications that address viable and sustainable solutions for the handling and removal of compost within the Town of Ashland will be given highest preference.
